

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Town Board, of the Town of Forestport would like to remind residents that under New York State Agriculture and Markets law, all dogs are required to be licensed by six (6) months of age.

To obtain a new license, a copy of the current Rabies Certificate is required. Proof is required if the dog has been spayed or neutered as well. The annual cost for a spayed/neutered dog is \$5.00 and an unspayed/unneutered dog is \$15.00. One tag is issued for the lifetime of the license; however, in the event of loss, can be replaced at an additional cost of \$3.00. A renewal letter will be sent on an annual basis, based upon the anniversary of the license. If submitting by mail/drop box please make sure your name, phone number and address are correct.

There are three ways to obtain a Dog license:

1. See the Town Clerk during normal business hours with your rabies certificate, proof of spay/neuter (if applicable) and fees mentioned above.
2. Drop off a copy of your rabies certificate and proof of spay/neuter (if applicable) along with fees mentioned above in the drop box located outside the Town office doors.
3. Mail a copy of your rabies certificate and proof of spay/neuter (if applicable) along with fees mentioned above to:

If you have a dog that is of age and unlicensed, you are in violation of State and Town statutes. Please be aware that if the Town conducts a dog enumeration, not only will you have to pay the licensing fee, but you will also have to pay an additional fee for having an unlicensed dog.
